Prince Henry's is a popular and over-subscribed 13-18 High School with approximately 1300 on roll including more than 330 in one of Worcestershire's largest Sixth Forms. The school enjoys an excellent reputation locally and has consistently been judged outstanding by Ofsted, most recently in May 2013. Two Ofsted Survey inspections undertaken during 2014 looking at provision for the most able students, and also for alternative curriculum provision both praised the school's ethos and its ability to deliver excellent teaching and learning to students of all abilities.

In May 2014, the school was awarded National Teaching School Status and, having been accredited with SCITT status in summer 2016, is currently training its second cohort of 17 trainee teachers.
