- Demonstrate you hold the right to work and study in the UK and have been a resident in the UK/EEA for the last three years.
- A Degree 2:2 or above (may accept a 3rd class degree in particular circumstances.)
- For some employment-based training routes, some school experience will be required, alongside a school to offer an employment contract.
- Stage 2 of the applications process if that you will need to complete a DfE application form to train to teach and pass all criteria of the Initial Teacher Training provider.

Funding/Salary
